We are an open church of around 60 members with a reputation over many years for being friendly, and trying to make everyone feel welcome, whether you're a visitor or you've come a hundred times before.

We're committed to using the Bible to determine how we meet together, how we worship and what we do in the community. We are convinced that God is just as relevant to our world today as when the Bible was written and we seek to share this with everyone.

We believe we have had an impact over the past 60 plus years in Canley and we want to continue to be a significant influence for God in our local area and through our members and contacts; there are currently lots of groups that meet in the church building and our members are involved in many different community groups — and we want to continue to build on this work.

Main purpose of the role
